### Lloyd E. Privott Sr.

October 25, 1923 – February 16, 2011

Lloyd E. Privott Sr, was born to Josephus and Kate Privott in Edcllton, N.C, on October 25th, 1923. He had one sister and brother (both deceased), Hilda Thornton and Earl Privott. Llyod attended Warren Grove School on Edenton, N.C. Throughout his life Lloyd worked a variety of jobs one of which he worked as a tractor trailer driver, cultivating land.

In 1942 Lloyd joined the marines, and was stationed at Montiford Point. There he was one of many called the "Marines of Montford Point" being one of the first black marines in his regime., Lloyd served a two year term in which he became a marine policeman. After being honorably discharged Lloyd later moved to New York residing at 194 Malcolm X Blvd, Brooklyn New York for 40 years.

Lloyd worked 38 years as a shop steward before retiring at the age of 65. Lloyd departed this life on February 16, 2011. He was the father of the late Barbara Latham, Thomas Privott and James Robinson. He leaves behind his other children: Lloyd Jr., Joyce, Samantha, William and Paulette. Lloyd also leaves behind his stepchildren, grand and great grand children, nieces, nephews as well as a host of friends and family. Far too many to be mentioned. Lloyd will be missed.
