## OBITUARY

While attending Morehouse College, he enlisted in the United States Marines in 1947, where he served three years. In 1950, Homer married Jewell McCoy, and to this union came Angela and Gregory Biggs. He then moved back to Atlanta and finished college at Morehouse, where he attended classes with Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. He also opened a furniture and appliance store.

Homer later moved to Detroit and married Shirley Dudley (deceased) in 1970, and to this union came Kenyatta Biggs and Linda Dudley.

Homer came to Detroit and gained employment at General Motors. While in Detroit, he also opened his own carpet store, Discount Carpet King. He retired from General Motors and became a full time carpet salesmen until his death. Besides cooking, reading and his family, selling carpet was his joy.
